
Five points of a new architecture:

- 1. pilotis columns in grid instead of load bearing walls
- 2. roof garden ← usage of flat roof
- 3. free design of ground plan ← usage of grid
- 4. free design of facade ← usage of grid
- 5. horizontal window ← usage of grid


