- - submitted plans in time (all floor-plans, min. two sections, all elevations 1:100, min. one section 1:50 and partly 1:20, site plan 1:500/200, detail drawings 1:10, 1:5 and model 1:200 + booklets with specifications and studies - approved by all associate consultants)
- Deadline: 18th of MAY, or 22th of MAY (with delay fee) 12AM
- Complete presentation project (except of final model) has to be submitted on 18th June 12AM
- Presentations start from 29th June.

- Way of completion:
- - active participation in consultations with home-prepared plans and models
- - completing condition of Code of Studies - parts: diploma project
- - regular consultation with associate consultants (structures, building construction, site management, building services)
- - submission of complete project plan before deadline
